Task Organization: Annex A

1. SITUATION.

a. Enemy. See Annex B, (Enemy Order of Battle)

b. Friendly.

(1) The President of the UNITED STATES has sent a personal message to the leaders of the Krasnovian and Pahrumpian Coalition (KPC) stating that a war with Mojavia would involve our vital national interests. Members of the Department of Defense Indications and Warning System, particularly DIA, HQDA, and USIRCOM have increased their Watch Condition to WATCHCON 1, and the MOJAVE-KRASNOVIA problem is the number one priority within the intelligence community. The National Security Council recommended to the President that a U.S. Joint Task force prepare for contingency operations. The SECDEF has authorized contingency planning for military actions to deter KPC aggression, and if necessary, to eject KPC forces from Mojavia to restore the international border and restore the region to pre-conflict conditions. As a result, the SECDEF has activated U.S. Joint Task Force (USJTF MOJAVIA) for the planning and potential deployment to MOJAVIA. O/O, 3D BCT, 1CD is attached to the 52nd ID (M) for MTC planning within the USIRCOM AOR.

(2) X (US) Corps Mission. TBP

(3) Corps Commander's Intent. TBP

(4) 52 ID (M) continues offensive operations. On order, move to AAs to complete preparations for combat operations to demonstrate U.S. resolve and deter KPC aggression.

(5) Division Commander's Intent. TBP

2. MISSION. 3rd BCT prepares to conduct combat operations for MTC. On order, conducts combat operations to deter or eject Krasnovian forces from MOJAVIA and restore the international boundary. On order, conducts post conflict operations to maintain stability and restore the region to pre-conflict conditions.

3. EXECUTION.

Commander's Intent:

PURPOSE: Conduct MTC to engage enemy forces while maintaining 70% combat power for future offensive operations.

KEY TASKS:

- Seize key terrain vicinity Iron Triangle and Division Hill.
- Detect and destroy all enemy vehicles west of PL Dan.
- Incorporate the "CAV BIG 8" in all operations
- Ensure risk management is executed to standard
- Maintain 100% accountability of personnel, equipment, vehicles, and sensitive items

ENDSTATE: Ensure greater than 70% combat power and enemy vehicles are west of PL Dan.

a. Concept of the Operation: 3d BCT executes Movement to Contact (MTC) as a sequel to OCONUS deployment into MOJAVIA. MTC consists of four critical tasks: 1 – The Reconnaissance, surveillance, and observation (RS&O). 2 – Seize key terrain vicinity Iron Triangle and Division Hill. 3 – Engage enemy vicinity EA Shiner and EA Miller. 4 – Regeneration, ensure 70%+ combat power.

(1) Phase I – RS&O

(2) Phase II – Seize key terrain vicinity Iron Triangle and Division Hill

(3) Phase III – Engage enemy vicinity EA Shiner and EA Miller

(4) Phase IV - Regeneration, ensure 70%+ combat power
